2019 Free Online Regulatory Update

Look for your email invitation

What does the update cover?

The new industry Code of Conduct, important amendments to the *Motor Dealer Act* and the proper selling of modified vehicles.

How do I take the course?

A link in the email will take you directly to the VSA e-learning website. **No registration or fee is required if you complete the course within two weeks of your notice.**

You do not need to do anything until you get your email invitation.

Is the update mandatory?

Yes. Completion of the course and an acknowledgement of the Code is mandatory.

Who must take the course?

Salespeople, broker agent representatives and a person with the authority to bind every dealership, wholesaler or broker agent must take the course and acknowledge the terms of the Code of Conduct.

Why just two weeks to complete?

The government mandated that every VSA licensee be quickly informed of the Code of Conduct and acknowledge the terms. This regulatory update has no initial fee and a two week deadline so that these requirements set by government can be met.

What happens if I don't complete the update during my two weeks?

You will have to register for the course and pay the \$85 CE course fee. The Registrar will also be notified. The Registrar can determine if conditions need to be placed on your licence or if your licence will be suspended until the course is completed.
